COURSE DETAILS

In all forms of treatment, the patient is the focus, and the dentist must consider every potential outcome of therapy and adapt the treatment according to the individual patient's needs. The more the clinician knows about dental treatment solutions, the more difficult it can be to choose the proper rehabilitation techniques. To that end, the clinician should not lose sight of the therapeutic goal of the treatment plan. For these difficult cases, the dentist could transfer new digital applications and work flows, without forgetting the analog steps for predictable outcome in esthetically and functionally driven reconstructive therapy.

Whether a single tooth restoration in the esthetic area or a full-mouth rehabilitation, all steps must be considered. A promising strategy in dental reconstruction is not just the application of the digital technology in single steps, but also the intelligent linking of analog and digital procedures in a comprehensive treatment workflow.

The lecture will point out the essential analog steps regarding both planning and implementation for superior functional and esthetic outcomes in complex cases, utilizing digital work flows to support optimal patient outcomes. In the end, the positive esthetic outcomes and the functional effectiveness and efficiencies will reflect the treatment success.
